


YOUTH OF THE YEAR

Indiana's Youth of the Year will progress to regional and possibly national events that culminate in a weeklong celebration in Washington DC, where one individual is named the National Youth of the Year and receives a \$50,000 scholarship, a brand-new Toyota Corolla and a \$5,000 Kohl's gift card.
