COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What if I have too much to fit in the provided tub?

Please use as many containers as necessary to get those recyclables on the curb. As long as your products are separated into the proper categories ... you may use as many containers as you wish. Common extra containers would be five gallon buckets, crates or even trash cans.

2. Why were my items left on the curb?

Two reasons for finding items left on the curb are:

- Improperly separated items.
- Items left out to be collected that are not recyclable.
- Newspapers are wet. Do not set out if rain is expected.

Between regular pick-ups recyclables can be dropped off at the Recycling Center located at 3326 Mitchell Road M-F 6:00am-6:00pm Sat. 7:00am-5:00pm Sun. 12:00pm-6:00pm If you are unsure about certain items, please call us!

Each family can request a tub if needed in which to place recycling products. Recycle tub must be placed where your weekly trash is now picked up, only every other week.

Please store your tub inside. Do not leave outside as it will deteriorate much faster and would create an eyesore in your neighborhood. You may request a new tub if ours has deteriorated.

Please place only the accepted listed materials in your bin. All unacceptable items will be left in your bin on the curb.

GLASS



Accepted: Food and beverage containers only. Remove all lids.

Not Accepted: Window glass, ceramics, light bulbs or glass cookware.

METAL CANS



Food cans, labels may be left on. **NO** clothes hangers, skillets, utensils, pans, etc.

PLASTIC BOTTLES



#1through #7 jugs and bottles -look on bottom for number. Milk and water jugs, soda bottles, soap bottles, and detergent bottles. **NO** lids, oil jugs, antifreeze jugs, party trays, styrofoam, egg cartons, clear plastic coverings and wrappings, plastic utensils, plastic shopping bags.

MAGAZINES & OTHER PAPER



Magazines, junk mail, phonebooks, shredded paper, and office paper should be kept separate from newspaper. **NO** hard or soft cover books are to be placed in your paper recyclables.

NEWSPAPERS



Place your newspaper and slick inserts in a brown paper bag and put on top of your recycling bin. This will allow you to have 6 separate products per pick- up. Dry newspapers only.

PAPERBOARD & CARDBOARD



Accepted: Cardboard and paperboard (cereal boxes, etc.). Dog and cat food bags, brown paper grocery bags, brown kraft envelopes. Please remove styrofoam liners.

ALUMINUM CANS



Beverage cans, aluminum foil, pie pans, etc. **NO** aluminum products such as chairs, siding, etc.
