ORDER OF JUDICIAL
DISSOLUTION

The Plaintiff, Office of the Indiana Attorney General, having filed its Verified Motion for Default Judgment, and the Court, having read the same and being duly advised in the premises, now finds:

- 1. On or about February 25, 2025, Plaintiff filed its Complaint in this matter, alleging that Defendant was operating a fraudulent domestic Indiana limited liability company for the purpose of defrauding United States Citizens.
- 2. Based on Plaintiff's attempts at perfecting service, including a Field Investigator attempting to serve a person located at the Defendant's registered agent address, the Court finds that service should be imputed to Defendant such that the Court maintains jurisdiction over Defendant in this matter.
- 3. The Court finds that the Plaintiff has made an adequate showing in its pleadings that the Defendant obtained its articles of incorporation through fraud and/or has exceeded or abused its authority to conduct business by using the

corporate form in furtherance of illegal activities.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Motion for Default Judgment is GRANTED in favor of Plaintiff, State of Indiana, Office of the Indiana Attorney General, and against Defendant Go Go Travel Consulting, LLC.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that Go Go Travel Consulting, LLC is hereby judicially dissolved as of the date of this Order pursuant to Ind. Code § 23-1-47-1 and shall carry out no further business in the State of Indiana. The Clerk is directed to deliver a certified copy of this judgment to the Indiana Secretary of State, who shall file it.
